## Application process

Candidates must be American citizens and must be duly certified and hold a valid teacher license in the US.

International teachers will also be considered, as long as they are from Commonwealth countries and shall also hold a valid teaching credential and /or relevant teaching education and experience in the US.

## Required qualifications

- Bachelor or Master Degree in Education or related area you applying for.
- Qualified Teacher Status or other Certifications.
- Experience in International Schools.
- Spanish work permit, NIE and Social Security Number.
- DBS/CRB/List 99 or equivalent Certificates to demonstrate clearance to teach (Absence of criminal/sexual offenses).

- Contribute to learning processes and curriculum development (ib & American Standards).
